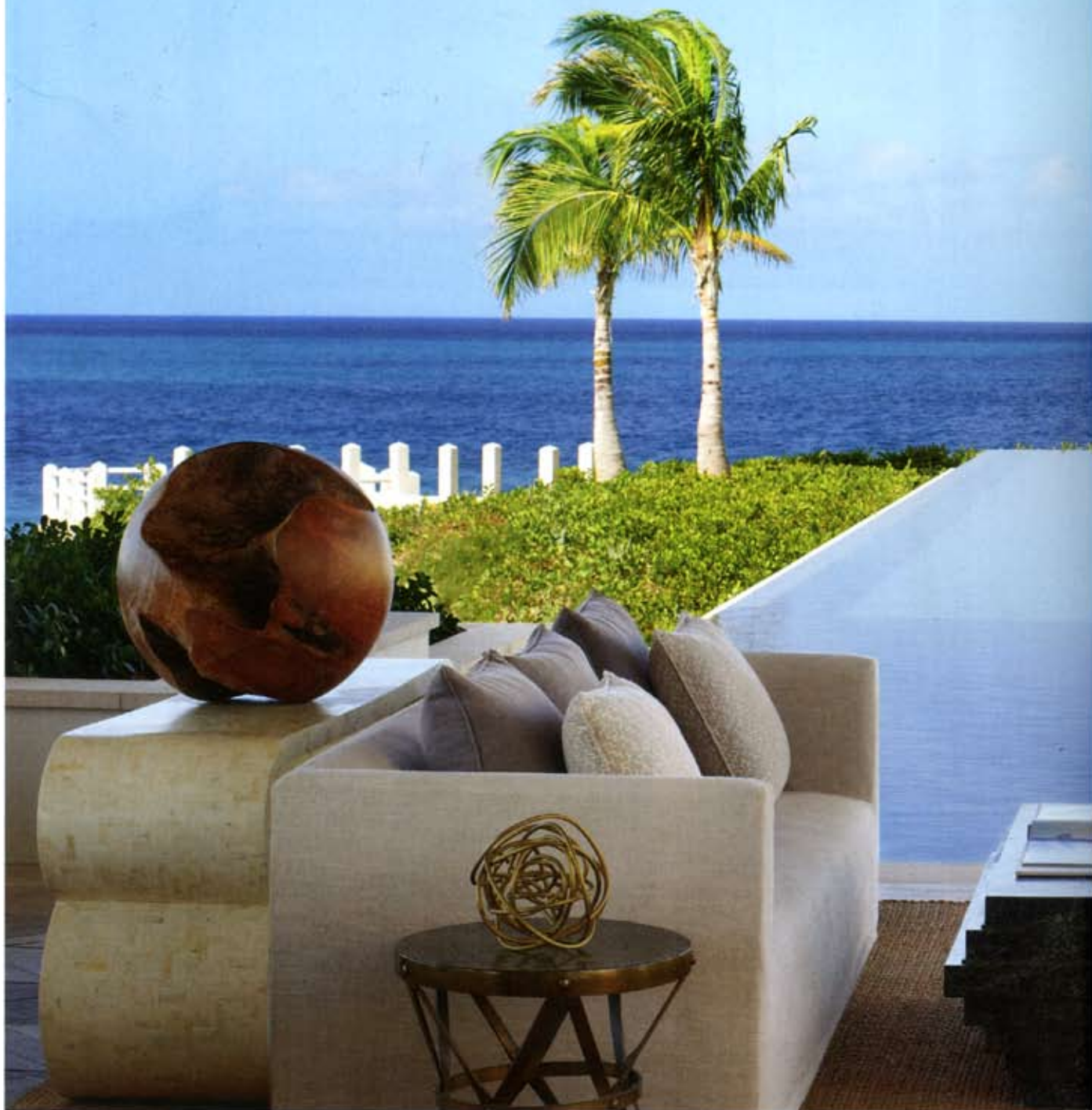
In contrast to Anguilla's traditional, enclosed Mediterranean-style architecture, the architectural firm of Wimberly Allison Tong & Goo created an environment that exudes modern glamour and lets in the tropics with high glass walls flooded with natural light and 200-plus pools and water features that reflect the Caribbean sun. With sophisticated and contemporary interiors by renowned interior designer Kelly Wearstler, Viceroy Anguilla showcases a relaxed chic sensibility with organic elements, such as driftwood lamps, petrified-wood tables and travertine marble floors, that add a tasteful juxtaposition to the geometric lines of the architecture.

Each villa overlooks the ocean with breathtaking views of the Caribbean and a private pool. Rooms range from a studio to five bedrooms, though whatever accommodations are chosen, each one features custom-designed furnishings beautifully styled by Wearstler in a chic palette that mixes warm woods with the sleek look of contemporary hardware.

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## VICEROY ANGUILLA

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Luxury amenities include wireless broadband, high-definition plasma TVs, espresso machines and Serta Eurotop pillow-top mattresses and feather duvets. Opulent baths feature marble countertops, soaking tubs and travertine showers with rain-head faucets. Rooms of two bedrooms or larger include full kitchens and washer/dryers, while villas and townhomes boast expansive outdoor spaces with al fresco kitchens and private infinity pools.

From beachside grills to signature dining, family style to tapas, an eclectic array of dining ambiances and menu selections can be found. Cobà, the resort's signature restaurant, incorporates Asian-style local produce and seafood, while the more casual Bamboo Bar & Grill presents barefoot beach barbecues against the sounds of steel drums and tiki torches. Serving Caribbean and Continental cuisine for breakfast, lunch and dinner, the Aleta terrace restaurant overlooks the sunrise pool, while the hip and intimate Half Shell bar serves frozen cocktails and an array of chilled cold fare. The resort also offers healthy spa cuisine, as well as in-room dining.

Each of the three pools, as well as the beach, affords a relaxing experience with pampering services. A swim-through grotto between the two bays features prime snorkeling, while an aquatic center provides an array of non-motorized sports and the 8,000-square-foot spa and fitness center features a vast collection of wellness rituals for the body and soul.
