WHY NOW There are always reasons to visit Anguilla's chichi 40 square miles—British gentility, flawless beaches, serene sailing trips—and now there are a few more: Flights from U.S. hubs are 30 percent lower this month than the same time last year, and **The Viceroy**, a pretty beechwood-hued resort on 35 bayside acres, popped up in November. Its 166 Kelly Wearstler-designed rooms and villas come with a third night free through January 31 (866-270-7798; doubles, \$695). At the *Condé Nast Traveler* Gold List-ranked **Cap Juluca**, even basic rooms evoke Moorish aristocracy with a domed beachfront terrace, marble shower, and Persian rugs throughout the 700 square feet. Book three nights through April 4 and get the fourth free, or stay seven nights for the price of five (888-858-5822; doubles, \$995–1,095).
