New resorts, celeb chefs, design stars and splashy upgrades make the case for a trip to the Caribbean now

THE ISLAND: **Anguilla**

THE PITCH: Royalty-attracting isle adds a Viceroy

Despite tabloid fame earned years back when Jen and Brad had their breakup talk here, this British territory remains a rustic and less touristy destination. And that'll continue to be the case if hotel development is limited to resorts like the new Viceroy

Anguilla (*rates from \$395, viceroyhotelsandresorts.com/anguilla*). With interiors designed by Kelly Wearstler, the spectacular, marbled stone slab development complements its 3,200

feet of beachfront. **WHERE (ELSE) TO STAY:** Celeb-fave Cap Juluca (*rates from \$425, capjuluca.com*) recently took over management of the island's only golf course, Temenos (created by Greg Norman); and CuisinArt Resort and Spa (*rates from \$400, cuisinartresort.com*) makes "family friendly" seem positively elegant.

WHEN TO GO: High season is November through July, but go in late March, when local reggae legend Bankie Banx hosts the three-day Moon Splash music festival at his rickety beachside bar and restaurant, Dune Preserve (*bankiebanx.net*).
